Boy's Springtime Vest

Description: This handsome vest, worked in one piece from the bottom ribbing to the top, is worked in single and double crochet. Shown here in Pastel Blue, it is sure to be a favorite during Spring and Summer and would be a great finishing touch for that special Easter outfit.

Difficulty: Easy

Size(s): 10

Yarn(s): Lion Brand Baby Soft, Light (3), 1-5 oz. skeins, (shown in Pastel Blue #106). *Note: I have not tested the vest in this size so a second skein may be needed.*

Hook(s): I/9 Hook or to obtain gauge

Other: Tapestry needle for weaving in ends

Gauge: 20 sc = 5" (12.7 cm); 20 rows = 4" (10.2 cm)

Stitches Used: Single crochet, single crochet in back loop only, single crochet two together (insert hook in first stitch, yarn over and pull through, insert hook in second stitch, yarn over and pull through, yarn over, pull through all loops on hook), double crochet, slip stitch

Pattern Abbreviations: Chain (ch), stitch(es) (st(s)), single crochet (sc), back loop only (blo), slip stitch (sl st), repeat (rep), round(s) (rnd(s)), single crochet two together (sc2tog), remaining (rem)



Instructions:

Ribbing:

- 1. Ch 8. Sc in second ch from hook and each remaining ch across. (6 sc)
- 2. Ch 1. Turn. Sc in first sc. Sc in blo in each rem sc. (6 sc)
- 3. Rep row 2 for 122 more rows. (124 rows of 6 sc)

SI st two short edges together.

Body:

Rotate to work across the long edge. The body is worked in rounds. Do not turn after each round. The outside will be the wrong side.

1. Ch 1. Work 124 sc across. Sl st in first sc to join. (124 sc)



- 2. Ch 1. Sc in each sc around. Join with sl st to first sc. (124 sc)
- 3. Repeat rnd 2 for 68 more rnds. (70 rnds of 124 sc)

Back Top (Right):

The top is worked in rows. Turn when instructed to do so.

- 1. SI st in first 7 sts. Ch 1. Sc in next 48 sts. Leave remaining sts unworked. (48 sc)
- 2. Ch 1. Turn. Sc to end of row. (48 sc)
- 3. Rep row 2 for 24 more rows. (26 rows of 48 sc)
- 27. Ch 1. Turn. Sc in next 12 sts. Sl st in next24 sts (for the neck opening). Ch 1. SC in remaining sts. (12 sc)
- 28. Ch 1. Turn. Sc in each of the 12 sc. (12 sc)
- 29. Rep row 22 for 6 more rows. (8 rows of 12 sc)
- 35. Turn. SI st in each sc. Fasten off.

Back Top (Left):

Join yarn in first sc to left of the 24 sl st for the neck opening.

- 1. Ch 1. Sc to end of row. (12 sc)
- 2. Ch 1. Turn. Sc to end of row. (12 sc)

- 3. Rep row 2 for 5 more rows. (8 rows of 12 sc) Note: The first row of 12 sc was made on row 27 of the Back Top (Right)
- 9. Turn. SI st in each sc. Fasten off.

Front Top (Right):

Join yarn at side seam.

- SI st in first 7 sts. Ch 1. Sc in next 20 sts. Leave remaining sts unworked. (20 sc)
 Ch 1. Turn. Sc in each sc across. (20 sc)
- 3. Rep row 2. (20 sc)
- 4. Ch 1. Turn. Sc2tog. Sc in each rem sc. (19 sc)
- 5. Ch 1. Turn. Sc in each sc across. (19 sc)
- 6. Rep row 5. (19 sc)
- Ch 1. Turn. Sc in first 17 sc. Sc2tog. (18 sc)
- 8. Ch 1. Turn. Sc in each sc across. (18 sc)
- 9. Rep row 8. (18 sc)
- 10. Ch 1. Turn. Sc2tog. Sc in each rem sc. (17 sc)
- 11. Ch 1. Turn. Sc in each sc across. (17 sc)
- 12. Rep row 11. (17 sc)
- 13. Ch 1. Turn. Sc in first 15 sc. Sc2tog. (16 sc)
- 14. Ch 1. Turn. Sc in each sc across. (16 sc)
- 15. Rep row 14. (16 sc)
- 16. Ch 1. Turn. Sc2tog. Sc in each rem sc. (15 sc)

17. Ch 1. Turn. Sc in each sc across. (15 sc) 18. Rep row 17. (15 sc) 19. Ch 1. Turn. Sc in first 13 sc. Sc2tog. (14 sc) 20. Ch 1. Turn. Sc in each sc across. (14 sc)

- 20. Ch 1. Turn. Sc in each sc across.
- 21. Rep row 20. (14 sc)
- 22. Ch 1. Turn. Sc2tog. Sc in each rem sc. (13 sc)
- 23. Ch 1. Turn. Sc in each sc across. (13 sc)
- 24. Rep row 23. (13 sc)
- 25. Ch 1. Turn. Sc in first 11 sc. Sc2tog. (12 sc)
- 26. Ch 1. Turn. Sc in each sc across. (12 sc)
- 27. Rep row 26 for 8 more rows. (10 rows of 12 sc)
- 35. SI st in each sc across. Fasten off.

Front Top (Left):

Skip 8 st to the left of the top right section and join yarn.

- 1. Ch 1. Sc in next 20 sts. (20 sc)
- 2. Ch 1. Turn. Sc in each sc across. (20 sc)
- 3. Rep row 2. (20 sc)
- 4. Ch 1. Turn. Sc in first 18 sc. Sc2tog. (19 sc)
- 5. Ch 1. Turn. Sc in each sc across. (19 sc)
- 6. Rep row 5. (19 sc)
- 7. Ch 1. Turn. Sc2tog. Sc in each rem sc. (18 sc)

8. Ch 1. Turn. Sc in each sc across. (18 sc)

9. Rep row 8. (18 sc)

- 10. Ch 1. Turn. Sc in first 16 sc. Sc2tog. (17 sc)
- 11. Ch 1. Turn. Sc in each sc across. (17 sc)
- 12. Rep row 11. (17 sc)
- 13. Ch 1. Turn. Sc2tog. Sc in each remaining sc. (16 sc)
- 14. Ch 1. Turn. Sc in each sc across. (16 sc)

15. Rep row 14. (16 sc)

- 16. Ch 1. Turn. Sc in first 14 sc. Sc2tog. (15 sc)
- 17. Ch 1. Turn. Sc in each sc across. (15 sc)
- 18. Rep row 17. (15 sc)
- 19. Ch 1. Turn. Sc2tog. Sc in each rem sc. (14 sc)
- 20. Ch 1. Turn. Sc in each sc across. (14 sc)
- 21. Rep row 20. (14 sc)
- 22. Ch 1. Turn. Sc in first 12 sc. Sc2tog. (13 sc)
- 23. Ch 1. Turn. Sc in each sc across. (13 sc)
- 24. Rep row 23. (13 sc)
- 25. Ch 1. Turn. Sc2tog. Sc in each rem sc across. (12 sc)
- 26. Ch 1. Turn. Sc in each sc across. (12 sc)
- 27. Rep row 26 for 8 more rows. (10 rows of 12 sc)
- 35. SI st in each sc across. Fasten off.

Finishing:

Line up front and back pieces and sl st shoulder seams together. Join yarn at bottom left of front neck opening and dc around to bottom right corner of neck opening. Join with sl st to second sc to left of bottom right corner. Slip stitch first 8 dc on left and right front sides together. Sl st around arm openings. Weave in all ends.
